Terms & Conditions

- The Global Canvas 2022 children's art competition is run by the David Shepherd Wildlife Foundation (DSWF). It is open from **Thursday 8 July 2021 until Friday 11 February 2022**. **No entries will be accepted after the deadline.**
- Each entry must comprise of work undertaken by a child or children aged 16 and under at the deadline date of **Friday 11 February 2022**. Group and individual entries will be judged separately and in the following age categories - age 4 to 7 years, age 8 to 11 years and age 12 to 16 years.
- All entries must interpret the Global Canvas 2022 theme which is "Forests of Land and Sea" which celebrates forests on land and beneath the waves.
- All entries must be received digitally by **Friday 11 February 2022**. No physical artwork should be sent to DSWF. Entry to the competition requires digital photographs of your completed artwork to be submitted.
- Entries will be judged on the quality of art, interpretation of the theme, creativity, and for group entries - level of collaboration. The decision of the judges will be final. Competition winners will receive vouchers for art supplies, digital animal adoptions and certificates.
- Each group and individual entry must comprise of a fully completed group or individual entry form, completed by a responsible adult aged over 18, up to 3 photographs and a video. The accompanying video (up to 3 minutes in length) must also be sent via a file sharing site like WeTransfer, Dropbox or Google Drive to DSWF's Education Manager jo.elphick@davidsshepherd.org.
- Permission from each student's parent/legal guardian must be sought prior to submission as photographs and video of each entry will be used in the virtual final, website, social media, email and press.
- Overall and category winners may have their submitted video played during the virtual competition prizegiving which will be hosted on YouTube after the event. For individual entries, please note that we may use your name (first name and first initial of surname), age and country of residence for the purpose of identifying you as the creator of your entry.
- DSWF reserve the right to cancel the Global Canvas 2022 competition should circumstances arise out of our control that make this necessary.
- Entries are free but any donations to DSWF's charitable work can be made either by cheque made payable to 'DSWF' and sent to 'Global Canvas Art Competition, DSWF, Saba House, 7 Kings Road, Shalford, Surrey GU4 8JU' (please include the name of the group / school or individual you are donating from) or by calling the office Mon-Fri 9am-5pm on **01483 272323**.
